

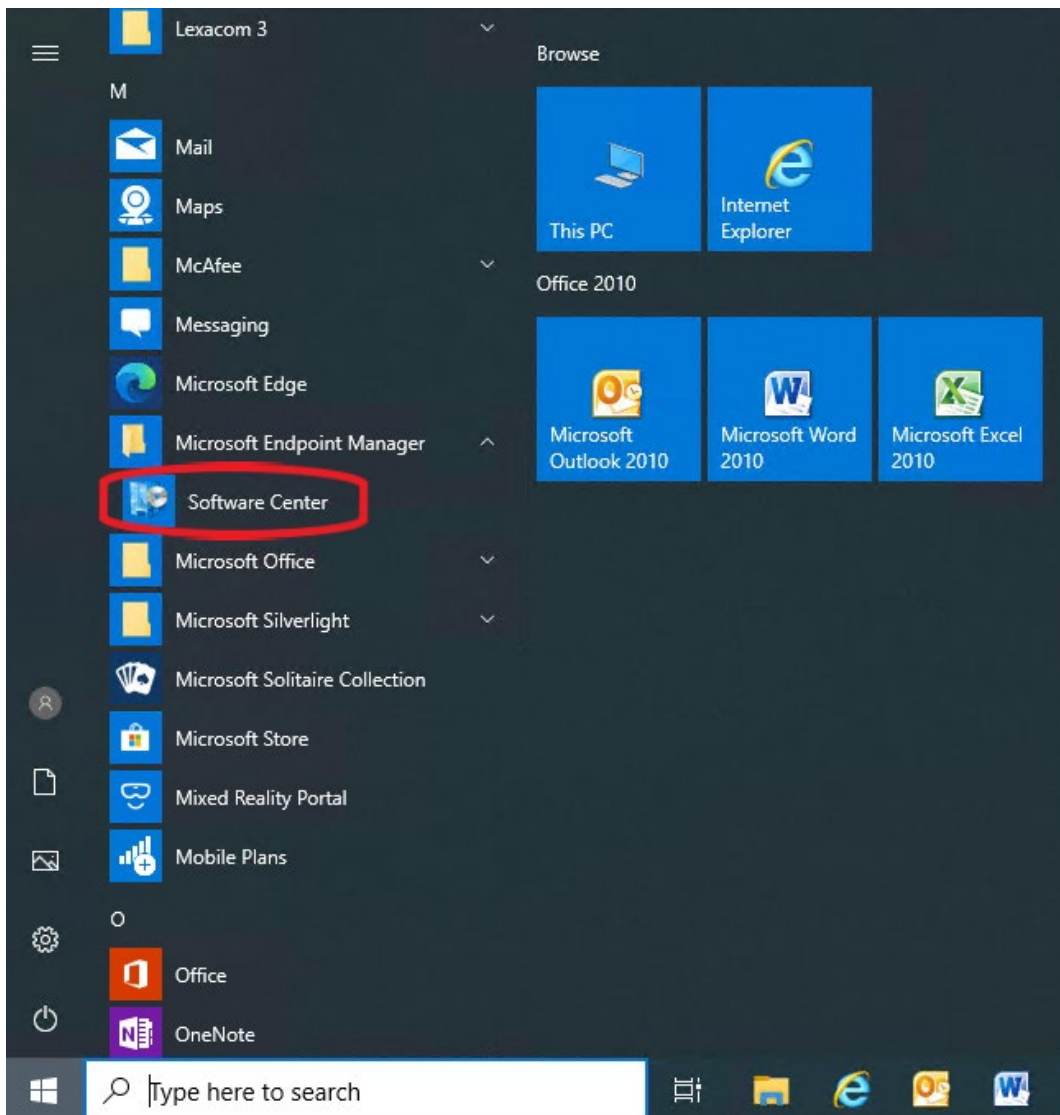
Manually Installing 20H2

PLEASE NOTE: This process may leave your system unusable for several hours. Please make sure you have a suitable window to perform this before continuing.



Step 1.

To install the Windows 20H2 feature Update manually, please click on the Windows Start button at the bottom left of the screen. Here, you can type Software Center (or navigate to Microsoft Endpoint Manager and select Software Center) to open the application.

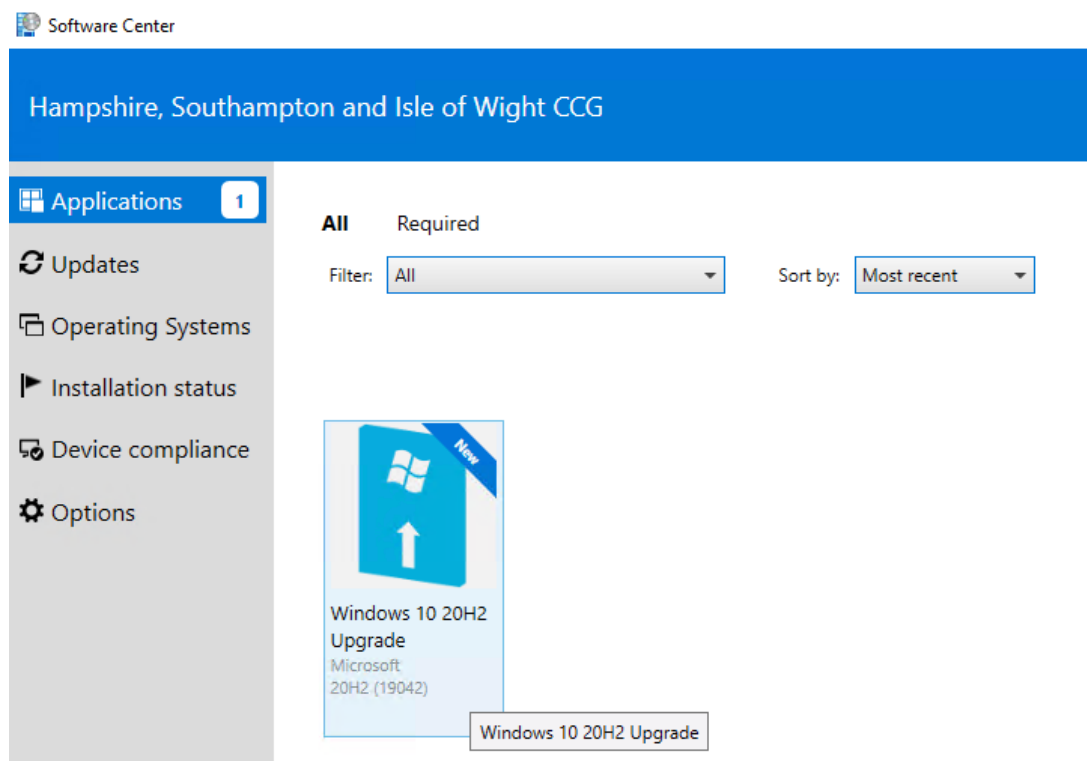


Please note:

If Software Center is not present, your workstation hasn't yet joined to the new management software (MECM) and requires an agent to install. Please make sure your system is attached to the practice network with connectivity and this should automatically occur within a few hours.

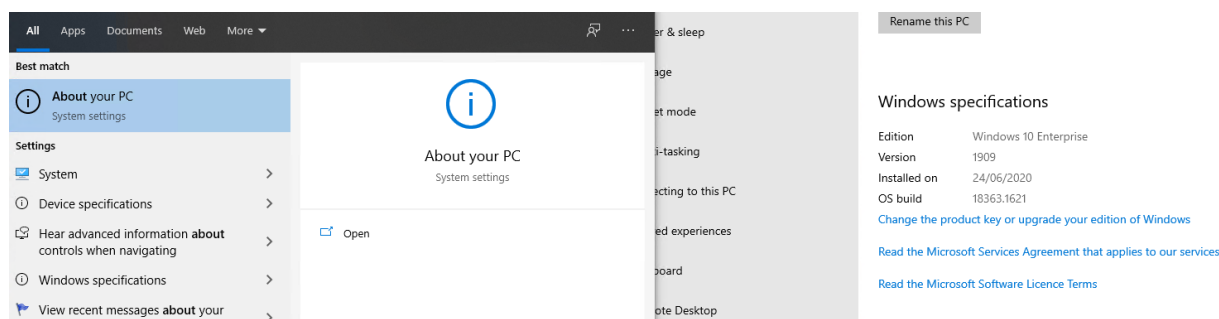
Step 2.

Once this has launched, you should be offered the upgrade, please click on the Windows 10 20H2 upgrade icon, as shown below.



Please Note:

If Software Center launches but the 'Windows 10 20H2 Upgrade' is not present, then you should have already have the upgrade installed and no further action is required. You can confirm this by typing 'About' into your start menu box and looking for the version within Windows specifications.



If '20H2' is present in the Version field then your upgrade has already completed.

Step 3.

You will then see the following screen, please click Install to begin the upgrade.
